Elections: Nomination forms are now up at each church. The following positions are leadership roles within our churches, so the primary qualities needed are faith and spirituality, with a desire to grow as a disciple of Jesus Christ and regularly pray for, serve and support the mission and ministry of our churches.

Church Wardens: Carry responsibility for the upkeep and maintenance of the church buildings. It is expected that Churchwardens will, whenever possible, attend one of the main Sunday services. They will liaise regularly with the Assistant Warden(s) ensuring there is cover for each service, and be available for: PCC meetings, Standing Committee meetings, Building Team meetings and meetings with the vicar.

Assistant Church Wardens: Assisting the Church Wardens in their duties: being present at one service each week, co-ordinating the Sides Persons and the practical running of the services and be available for bi-monthly PCC meetings.

PCC Members: are representatives of the congregations and responsible for decisions about the mission and ministry of our churches. It is expected that each PCC member will: regularly attend one main weekly Sunday service; occasionally attend other services in preparation for the annual review of our worship services; be available for bi-monthly PCC meetings and other meetings that might occasionally occur.

Anyone on the church's Electoral Role may stand for these positions and vote at the AGM. If you require any more information please speak to Tim or one of the Wardens.
